Native from Bulgaria, Olga Katkova-Trevino studied music since the age of five. She won a number of national competitions, toured all over Europe, and was featured on the Bulgarian National TV, before she arrived in the US on a full musical scholarship to pursue a degree in Violin Performance.

Olga Katkova-Trevino is most delighted to serve as the concertmistress of the Millennium Chamber Players ([mcplayers.com](http://mcplayers.com)), a new professional ensemble in Chicago. As the group's leading violinist, Olga has presented solo and chamber music performances featuring music by Brahms, Bartok, and Shostakovich. In addition, she led the Millennium Chamber Players orchestra in the recent performances of the operas "The Rape of Lucricia" by Briten and "The Marriage of Figaro" by Mozart.

In the past year, Olga was engaged as a member of the Chicago Civic Orchestra. She has also performed as a member or guest of a number of orchestras such as Illinois Symphony, Sinfonia di Concertante, Rockford Symphony, Green Bay Symphony, Chicago Chamber Orchestra, South Bend Symphony, and Ohio Light Opera.

Ms. Katkova-Trevino is passionate about teaching. She is collaborating with the Chicago Opera Theater as a Teaching Fellow in their opera outreach project directed to inner city schools. She also teaches violin to adults and children from in her studios in the British School and in Downtown Chicago.
